**Seniors are emailed all scholarship information and applications!**

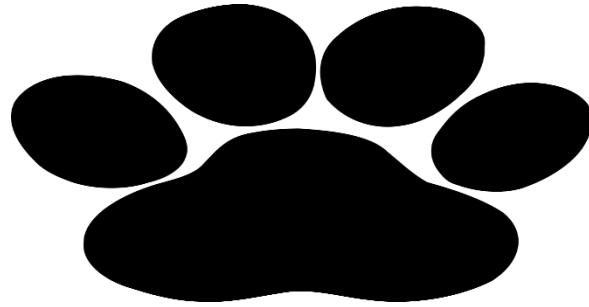
