### **\*\* Reminder for FFA Summer Fair for JH Students! \*\***

All exhibitors must be enrolled in Agriculture Education the previous year or have taken all of the Agriculture Education offered at his/her school. Current graduated seniors and midterm graduates are eligible to show.

- A member will be eligible after taking an Agricultural Class in 8<sup>th</sup> grade AND are enrolled in Intro to Agriculture for their Freshman year.
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade students are not eligible to show.
- Each high school member should have a Supervised Agriculture Experience (SAE) for each area that they are competing in.
- This change will go into place for the Summer 2025 Vo-Ag Fair for the Class of 2029.
